10 YEARS OF BRAVE ATTEMPTS!

On April 9, 2011, the Mississauga Lightning celebrated its 10th Anniversary of the Mississauga Invitational Floor Hockey Tournament. Returning to St.Augustine's Secondary School in Brampton, twenty-four teams representing Hamilton, London, Scarboro, Kingston, Toronto, Midland, Muskoka, Simcoe, Milton, Woolwich, Guelph, Peterborough, Newmarket, Owen Sound, and of course Mississauga participated in one of the largest Floor Hockey Tournaments in Canada and the largest 100% volunteer run Special Olympics event in the country! A record 42 games were played resulting in over 250 goals scored and the crowning of five Champions!

The host team Mississauga Lightning posted a 3-0 record and were the first champions of the day as they captured the Patrick Divison title. They are the first team in tournament history to win 4 Championships. The Campbell Divison was awarded to the stingy Kingston Kanucks, who on way to their first Mississauga Invitational title only allowed 3 goals all day while posting a 4-0 record! In the Norris Division, another first time Champion emerged as the Owen Sound Thunderbolts, who also lead the tournament in scoring with ana amazing 22 goals, also went undefeated at 4-0. The Adams division saw the Midland Hawks face off against the Hamilton Steelhawks – after tying in the round robin, the Steelhawks pulled off the victory in the finale with 2-1 victory! Finally, in one of the most exciting finishes in this tournaments history the Smythe Division Champiosnhip needed a double overtime before a winner was decided. Down 3-0, the Simcoe Spitfires fought back to force the OT against last years champs the Muskoka Ratlers. In the second OT Muskoka scored the winner and were able to hold onto the Smythe Championship for yet another year!

But it wasn't just the Champions that went home with hardware. At the end of the day, as each and every athlete recieved a trophy. At the Mississauga Invitational, "let me win" gets you a divisional championship and "let me be brave in the attempt" gets you an award! In the 10 years Mississauga has hosted this tournament over **3000** trophies, plaques or medals have been awarded!

With a record setting 42 games – quite possibly the most floor hockey games played in a single day at any Special Olympics floor hockey event – and over 1100 minutes of floor hockey, the results were simply amazing. This years tournament was by far the most intense and competive with nearly 60% of the games being decided by 2 goals or less! The one-time controversial, but now entrenched 'one goal per player, per game' rule, unique to this event has allowed this tournament to showcase the amazing talents of the entire floor hockey athlete population!

From its humble beginings as a small two divison 9 team tournament to the mega event it is today the success has always been a direct result of the volunteers. Made up mostly of the parents and family members of the host team, this group, year in and year out, make sure each and every athlete has a great time. We can not thank them enough! A huge thank you to our referrees, Bruce Gow, Lorne St. Louis, Brandon Azzopardi, Frank Jolic, Kevin Cooper, Anthony Scanlon, Mark Woods and Stewart Logan. They were an understaffed group that over delivered! Special thanks to Sherri Thomson for making all of those shirts and Principal Tom Iwasiw for opening up his school to us. A special pat on the back for all of the athletes, coaches and supporters who attended this event and who exemplified the 'brave attempt'. A personal thank you to Ann Labbe, who works tirelessly year in an year out to ensure everything gets done — and I mean EVERYTHING!
